<p>Taekwondo tidbits</p> <p>The late Grandmaster Richard Chun would always say that “The two techniques that can be used to measure a taekwondo black belts technical proficiency are the side kick and the double knife hand block.” This saying is often echoed by his disciple Grandmaster Doug Cook, my current teacher.</p> <p>The front kick (“ap chagi”) is sometimes called the “snap kick”, due to the incredible speed projected in this technique. It is one of the first kicks taught in taekwondo, however is often considered as one of the most powerful even at higher levels. (Reference: www.wuyi-taekwondo.com).
